The EUAA recognises that on occasion issues may arise which affect the quality of assessment tasks or procedures. According to the EUAA Assessment Appeal Procedure, you have the possibility to appeal the assessment on specific grounds as detailed below. You may submit an assessment appeal in relation to:

A substantive irregularity in the assessment procedure is an irregularity (unrelated to the question or task) that could conceivably interfere with the learner's performance during the assessment and can be verified by the invigilator.

A substantive irregularity in the assessment task is an issue relating to the wording of assessment questions or tasks that could negatively impact the learner's performance during the assessment.

You may <u>not</u> appeal because you disagree or are unhappy with the grade awarded.
